Our Clinic: The Student Health Services office provides routine, episodic, and urgent health care for students

Our Hours: Monday – Friday, 8:30am to 4:30pm when classes are in session. For after-hours or weekend care, students should contact their Primary Care Provider or access one of the off-campus medical care sites listed on the reverse. Public Safety staff is available 24/7 and can assist in emergencies.

Our Services are included in tuition. There are no office fees or co-pays for visits to Health Services or for point-of-care testing provided in clinic. You do not need to purchase the school health insurance plan to receive care at health services. However, you or your insurance may incur charges for additional medical services such as send-out lab tests, radiology tests, prescription medications, or ambulance transportation. Annual physical exams and immunizations are not available through Health Services. Students obtain those services through their Primary Care outside of school. Please call our office if you need help accessing these services.

Our Staff: Clinical services are provided by Massachusetts State Licensed and Nationally Board-Certified Nurse Practitioners who are able to evaluate and examine students, diagnose, order testing and prescribe medication.

Students can access clinic services easily, weekdays 8:30am to 4:30pm, by phone or email. Visits are by appointment, students need to call to schedule. We don't take walk-ins but can usually accommodate same-day and next-day appointments. The only exception to this policy is in the case of an emergency, where a student will be triaged.

Clinic services are confidential. Health Services maintains a policy of strict confidentiality for all services, conversations, and medical records. This information will only be released with the written consent of a student, 18 years or older, or as required by law. In keeping with federal law, no information is shared with anyone; staff, faculty, family, or friends. Information about care will only be given to someone with the student's specific written approval, except as required by law and in cases of danger to self or others.

Prescription Medications: There is no pharmacy on campus. Our nurse practitioners can write prescriptions, which students can pick up at a local pharmacy. Students who receive regular prescriptions via mail should do so when they are on campus.

Students should bring basic health care supplies with them to campus. It is a good idea to plan ahead for common illnesses and discomforts you may experience while living on campus. We recommend: thermometer, band-aids, acetaminophen (Tylenol), ibuprofen (Advil; Motrin), cold medicine, cough medicine, throat lozenges, chewable or liquid antacid, antibiotic ointment, reusable ice pack and hot water bottle.

Required Health Forms and Immunization Records are due July 31st (fall enrollment)/January 1st (spring enrollment). Detailed information about required forms can be found on our website: https://annamaria.edu/campus-life/health-counseling/medicat_required-forms/
