RN to BSN

Program Outcome 1 Program Completion Rate:

- a. **On time completion rate:** (ACEN to require this method of calculation, nursing program will use this method starting with the 2021-2022 academic year.)
60% or greater of the students will complete the program within 100% of the published program length beginning with enrollment into the first day of the first nursing courses (NUS 301 and NUS 320) and concluding with completion of the last 2 nursing courses in the published curriculum plan (NUS 431 and NUS 495). (Total of 2.5 consecutive academic semesters)

- b. **150% of Published Program Length Completion Rate:**
70% or greater of the students will graduate within 3 years from the date of admission into the RN to BSN program nursing course sequence.
